



Create a vision, goals, and strategy for a cohesive and recognizable destination district anchored by the Alliant Energy Center and lakefront for the benefit of area residents and visitors





The study will focus on the following six key elements in particular:

1. Land Use

 Identify general land uses that would contribute to a Destination District and potential redevelopment site

2. Placemaking


 Identify placemaking concepts and thematic needs to create a unified appearance and recognizable identity that will enhance visitor experience





3. Circulation and access in proximate area


- Analyze ingress and egress for the campus and District and bike/ped access to and throughout campus
- Analyze influence that changes in land use and increases in development intensity will have on transportation needs





4. Connections


- Analyze area street connections through the AEC and larger multi-modal connections between the AEC campus and downtown
- Analyze different options of connecting the AEC campus across John Nolen Drive to Lake Monona





5. Greenspace Integration


 Integrate and connect greenspaces and the lakefront as a unified whole offering a variety of experiences





6. Stormwater Management

 Identify documented existing stormwater challenges and potential solutions; identify opportunities to enhance water quality through future projects and public improvements




